The Imagine That mural team, directed by the acclaimed author-illustrator Joyce Raimondo, paints with students to create an uplifting character education mural tailored to your school. The mural illustrates your school slogan, character words, colors, and mascot. Input from the principal, PTA, and teachers, of the mural sketch is welcomed. The Imagine That! mural team folds into the art teacher's schedule of classes to paint the wall mural with every student in your school participating. Or, choose one or two grades to paint the mural. During each session, prior to painting,

our mural teachers lead discussions with the students about the character education words illustrated in the mural. For example, "What does respect mean? How might we show respect when working on the mural today?" The program serves as an inspiring and unifying project that lasts for years to come.

IMAGINE THAT! MURAL FEES:

Your mural can be painted on boards or directly on wall.
We create your mural with selected grades or the entire school.

ENTIRE SCHOOL - RESIDENCY PACKAGE FEES

Residency price includes mural design tailor made to your school.

5 days - up to six workshops per day = \$5,500 fold into the art teacher's schedule (up to 140 square feet)

4 days - up to six workshops per day = \$4,500 fold into art teacher's schedule (up to 130 square feet)

3 days - up to five workshops per day = \$3,500 (up to 120 square feet)

OR

FOR SMALLER BUDGETS - CHOOSE ONE OR TWO GRADES

Smaller murals include choice one of our mural designs with your school slogan.

Each class is \$375 for first session of the day and \$350 for each additional on same day. Mural size is according to price/number of sessions.

Two sessions \$725.
One mural size up to 24 square feet

Three sessions \$1,075
4 x 8 foot panel or mural painted directly on wall (up to 32 square feet)

Four sessions \$1,425
(up to 45 square feet)

Six sessions \$2,150
Two 4 x 8 foot panels side by side to create one mural or mural painted directly on wall
(up to 64 square feet)

Note:

Up to one class size - approximately 25-30 students in each workshop

Each workshop - about 45 minutes

Primed panels are provided by school.
